Through the unwavering support of our donors, partners, and volunteers, we successfully reached **123,051 beneficiaries**, offering vital assistance to those in need during this sacred month.

Our efforts included the distribution of **food packs**, the provision of **iftar meals**, access to **clean water**, and the **celebration of Eid**, which alone brought joy and relief to **5,027** families. Additionally, the **Musalla Project** in Gaza played a crucial role in creating safe and welcoming spaces for prayer, strengthening community bonds and spiritual growth.

This report highlights the positive outcomes of our Ramadan initiatives, offering a glimpse into the lives transformed by these acts of mercy and solidarity. As we move forward, we remain committed to expanding our efforts and continuing to make a meaningful difference in the lives of those who need it most.



RAMADAN FOOD

DISTRIBUTIONS

With the incredible support of our donors, we **distributed** 3,225 food packs across 12 countries, each pack designed to sustain families for the entire month. These food packs provided a sense of security and stability, allowing recipients to focus on their spiritual journey without the added burden of food scarcity.

In addition to the food packs, we hosted 45,035 Iftar meals across 12 countries, creating spaces of togetherness, dignity, and nourishment. For many, these meals were the only hot food they received each day. The Iftars brought people together and reminded them they were not alone.

Through these initiatives, we not only addressed immediate hunger but also fostered hope, unity, and compassion, the core values of Ramadan that continue to inspire our mission.

PALESTINE (Gaza)

In Gaza, where daily life continues to be marked by hardship and uncertainty, our Ramadan efforts brought critical relief and a sense of spiritual grounding. This year, Droplets of Mercy built a Musalla that accommodated 125 worshippers for daily prayers, offering a safe and sacred space for reflection during the blessed month.

To combat growing food insecurity, we distributed 375 food packs and served 3,250 Iftar meals to families. In response to the severe shortage of safe drinking water, we also delivered 30,000 litres of clean water.

These efforts provided not only immediate support, but also a sense of dignity, connection, and hope during one of the most spiritually significant times of the year.

PALESTINE (West Bank)

In the West Bank, we distributed **150 food packs** and served **4,050 lftar meals**, offering crucial support to families during Ramadan. These efforts helped alleviate hunger and fostered a sense of community, allowing people to come together in solidarity during the holy month.

Our team also conducted a **field visit** to directly assess the impact of our initiatives, ensuring the aid reached those who needed it most. Additionally, an **influencer visit** helped raise awareness about the ongoing needs in the region, inspiring further contributions and extending our reach.













YEMEN & JORDAN

In Yemen, we distributed **215 food packs** and served **3,750 lftar meals**, providing vital nourishment and relief to families facing ongoing challenges. These efforts helped ease the burdens of hunger and created spaces for community connection during Ramadan.

In Jordan, we distributed **220 food packs** and also provided **Eid clothing for children**, bringing joy and celebration to families during Eid. An influencer visit helped amplify the impact of our work, raising awareness and encouraging further support for those in need. Through these initiatives, we were able to offer both material aid and a sense of hope and dignity during this blessed month.





SYRIA & LEBANON

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In Syria, we distributed **275 food packs** and served **1,375 lftar meals**, providing essential support to families. We also facilitated the distribution of **Zakat al-Fitr**, ensuring that those in need could fulfill their religious obligations. To **celebrate Eid**, we organized a special event bringing joy and a sense of community during the holiday. Additionally, an **influencer visit** helped raise awareness and mobilize further support for our efforts in Syria.

In Lebanon, we provided **380 food packs** and served **500 lftar meals**, offering vital nourishment to families facing food insecurity. These efforts were a part of our broader mission to alleviate suffering and foster hope during the holy month of Ramadan. Through these initiatives, we were able to bring relief, dignity, and celebration to those who needed it most.

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PAKISTAN



In Pakistan, we distributed **100 food packs** and served **3,000 lftar meals**, providing essential nourishment to families throughout Ramadan. Alongside our food distribution efforts, we also raised and secured funds to install **23 hand pumps**, bringing access to clean water to rural communities. Each hand pump is expected to **serve 70-100 people**, depending on the size of the village. Alongside **5 solar water wells** that is expected to serve **250 - 750 people**, ensuring that families have a sustainable source of safe drinking water long after Ramadan ends.







BANGLADESH

In Bangladesh, we distributed **450 food packs** and served **3,000 Iftar meals**, providing essential nourishment to families in need during Ramadan. These efforts helped alleviate hunger and brought comfort to many as they observed the holy month.

Through these initiatives, we were able to offer both immediate relief and a sense of community, ensuring that families could break their fasts with dignity and peace.



UYGHUR & MALAYSIA

In Malaysia, Droplets of Mercy travelled to the Island of Semporna and distributed 200 food packs and served 700 Iftar meals, supporting families facing hardship during Ramadan. Our team also conducted a field visit to oversee the distribution and connect directly with the communities we served, ensuring the impact was both meaningful and effective.

For the Uyghur community in Turkey, we provided 200 food packs and 800 Iftar meals, helping families observe Ramadan with dignity despite their displacement. Our team's field visit, along with an influencer visit, helped shine a light on their ongoing struggles. We also supported both Iftar and Eid celebrations, bringing moments of joy, unity, and cultural connection during this sacred time.

SUDAN & UGANDA



In Sudan, we served **14,045 Iftar meals**, bringing much-needed nourishment to communities facing immense challenges. These meals provided not only physical relief but also moments of comfort and togetherness during a difficult time.

In Uganda, we distributed **160 food packs** and provided **900 Iftar meals** to vulnerable families, helping them observe Ramadan with dignity.








SOMALIA






KENYA

In Kenya, we distributed **300 food packs** and served **7,500 Iftar meals**, providing essential relief to families during Ramadan.

In addition to addressing immediate food needs, we also raised and secured funds to install **4 hand pumps and 8 solar wells**, providing sustainable access to clean water for communities in need. These efforts ensured not only nourishment but also long-term solutions for health and well-being, helping to empower families beyond the holy month of Ramadan.



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ZAKAT UL FITR

As the holy month of Ramadan came to a close, Droplets of Mercy ensured the timely and impactful distribution of Zakat ul-Fitr—an essential obligation for Muslims to support those in need before the Eid prayer. This year, we distributed **Zakat ul-Fitr** across two critically affected communities: **Syria and among Gazan evacuees currently residing in Egypt**.

In Syria, where conflict and displacement continue to devastate families, Zakat ul-Fitr provided urgent support to help cover basic needs such as food and essentials, enabling recipients to celebrate Eid with dignity and peace of mind. Similarly, for Gazan evacuees in Egypt—many of whom fled their homes under traumatic conditions—the support came as a vital lifeline during a time that is meant to be joyous and unifying.

Our local teams ensured that distributions were made in accordance with Islamic guidelines and prioritized those in greatest need. Through this initiative, we not only helped donors fulfill their religious duty, but also restored a sense of joy, inclusion, and humanity to families experiencing hardship. The impact of Zakat ul-Fitr goes beyond material aid—it carries with it a message of solidarity and compassion. Thanks to your generosity, hundreds were able to partake in Eid with dignity, knowing they were remembered and supported by a global community of care.





EID CELEBRATIONS



In Syria, Droplets of Mercy hosted a heartfelt Eid celebration, bringing joy and a sense of normalcy to families living through hardship. A communal Eid feast was shared with 250 families, allowing them to enjoy a warm, festive meal together. We also distributed gifts to 150 children, many of whom rarely experience the joy of receiving presents. The day was filled with entertainment, games, and fun activities designed to let children simply be children—laughing, playing, and creating memories. In total, 1,250 individuals participated in the celebration.

In Kenya, we celebrated Eid with 69 families—345 individuals—through a vibrant and joyful event in the heart of the community. The day began with Eid prayer followed by a shared breakfast, setting the tone for a day of gratitude and togetherness. We distributed Eid clothing to children, helping them feel special and included in the festivities. The celebration also featured games, activities, and a communal lunch, with the camp beautifully decorated to enhance the festive atmosphere.
